REMINDER REGARDING HOLY COMMUNION

Just a reminder that if you choose to receive Holy Communion in the hand as well as wear a mask when coming forward for Holy Communion, you are asked to remove/pull down your mask immediately BEFORE having the Sacred Host placed in your hand. In doing so in this manner, you can still reverently, carefully, and respectfully place the Holy Eucharist on your tongue in the proper way without having to worry about the mask. After you place the Sacred Host on your tongue, you may return/pull up the mask to its proper position. Also, if you receive Holy Communion in the hand, please make sure that the hand you use to receive the Sacred Host is extended properly and in an open FLAT position so that the Host can be safely placed in the palm of your hand. Please do not "cup" your hands together. This makes it difficult to place the Host in your hand without making contact. Your consideration in this matter is appreciated! Thanks!

SEATING IN CHURCH

Please note that the tape blocking off some of the pews in the church has been removed. You are asked to use prudence and common sense in practicing social distancing when seated in the pews for Mass. Thanks for your consideration in this matter for everyone's health and welfare!
