DIOCESAN SAFE ENVIRONMENT ANNOUNCEMENT

Any known or suspected abuse or neglect of a minor must first be immediately reported to the Missouri Child Abuse and Neglect Hotline (800-392-3738). Any known or suspected abuse or neglect of an adult must first be immediately reported to the Missouri Adult Abuse and Neglect Hotline (800-392-0210). In situations of immediate danger, call 911. Known or suspected abuse may also be reported to law enforcement in addition to making a report to the Missouri Child Abuse and Neglect Hotline or to the Missouri Adult Abuse and Neglect Hotline. Concerns and violations of "The Code of Conduct" should also be reported to the Office of Child and Youth Protection at <u>childandyouthprotection@dioscg.org</u> or 417-866-0841 or through the TIPS online reporting system available on the Diocesan website (<u>www.dioscg.org</u>.) Violations involving the Bishop should be reported to the Catholic Bishop Abuse Reporting System at 800-276-1562 or <u>https://reportbishopabuse.org/</u>. The Safe Environment Policy and Procedures, the Code of Conduct for Clergy, Employees and Adult Volunteers and other important information, including a link to the USCCB Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People, are available on the webpage <u>http://dioscg.org/child-youth-protection/</u>.

The mission and ministry of creating a safe environment for all flourish and thrive is a responsibility we all share. Before regularly working or volunteering with minors or vulnerable adults, all diocesan personnel are required to first complete 1) the Safe Environment Training; 2) have a Background Screening conducted; and 3) submit the current and signed Code of Conduct. The Safe Environment Training is now available online after creating an account in the VIRTUS system (through the VIRTUS webpage https://www.virtusonline.org/virtus/). The Code of Conduct is required annually and is made available at the beginning of the fiscal year, July 1, and expires December 31, the following year. The Background Screening Application is now accessed through the VIRTUS account. These forms and the Safe Environment Policies are available on the diocesan website under the Office of Child and Youth Protection.
