EUCCHARISTIC REFLECTION

Almost all species of fish cannot survive without being in water! This is the way God made them! Fish can survive outside of water, but only for a short period of time. Fish need water to live, thrive, and survive. It is similar with our soul and the Holy Eucharist. Just as fish need water to survive, our soul needs the Holy Eucharist to live, thrive, and survive. How do we know this? Jesus says so in the Gospel of St. John. Our Lord teaches very clearly that unless a person "eats My Flesh and drinks My Blood, he does not have life in him. Whoever eats My Flesh and drinks My Blood has eternal life and I will raise him on the last day, for the one who feeds on Me will have life because of Me". In our Catholic Faith, we believe that Jesus is referring to the Holy Eucharist in these words. So receiving our Lord in Holy Communion is necessary and essential to our eternal salvation and the well-being of our soul. Like fish out of water, our soul eventually "dies" without the Holy Eucharist. We can survive spiritually only for a short time without the Holy Eucharist. During this time of Eucharistic Renewal, may we come to a deeper knowledge and understanding of how precious and important the Most Holy Eucharist is to us. It is a necessary and essential element of our salvation!
